### ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

<b>What?</b>	This is an update to the Data Network Acceptable Use Policy. The policy was revised and expanded in scope to cover all technology use at Carolina.
<b>Who?</b>	This policy applies to everyone that uses technology that is owned by the University. This policy applies to the entire Carolina community, which includes faculty, staff, students, visitors, and everyone else that makes use of University technology.
<b>When?</b>	The ITS Policy Office is soliciting feedback from January 19th until February 9th.

### INFORMATION SECURITY CONTROLS STANDARD
