HIPAA SANCTIONS STANDARD

What? The Institutional Privacy Office has proposed this Standard to provide guidance and structure for the University in situations where HIPAA violations have occurred. HIPAA requires us to have a policy on this topic. Though the Standard looks like a bear to read through, it is worth a read if you are responsible for any students, staff, faculty, contractors, or others who come into contact with PHI as a function of their role at the University.
