## Revisions in Progress

### Vulnerability Management Standard

This will be a major overhaul of a Standard that has been a source of too much confusion. This revision will address gaps (Cloud, in-house application development, and others). In addition, the perceived “timeline conflict” for vulnerability remediation will be fixed by simply deferring to the SAI program timeline. The document reads almost entirely differently than the current version, so there isn’t a meaningful changes-tracked document to provide.

The ISO and several of your colleagues have put quite a bit of work into this new and improved version. Now it’s your turn to spot issues and make suggestions. Any time you can spend reviewing the draft would be a contribution to getting it right. It’s on our [ITS Policy Feedback page](#).

### Data Governance Standard

The Data Governance Standard was updated in the Spring. New processes and structures are forming up to support the changed framework.
